### SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

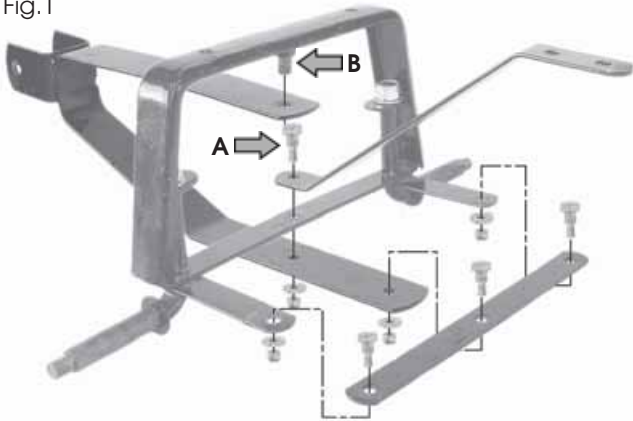
**⚠ WARNING!** Read these instructions before using the equipment. **⚠**

- **BEFORE** attempting to transport any load, ensure you are physically able to do so.
- **DO NOT** exceed the maximum working load for this garden cart - **150Kg**.
- **DO NOT** leave the cart on a gradient without first securely chocking the wheels.
- **DO NOT** allow children to play with or ride in the cart.
- **NEVER** use the cart if any of the tyres are deflated.
- **NEVER** use the cart to transport personnel or animals.
- **ALWAYS** inspect the cart for signs of wear or damage before use.
- **ALWAYS** ensure the load is evenly distributed and is perfectly stable.

# ASSEMBLY

1.

Assemble the steering linkage components as shown in fig.1. Shoulder bolts are used at all linkage points, the longest of the shoulder bolts is used at point 'A'. Secure the bracket at point 'B' using the supplied flat washer and split pin.

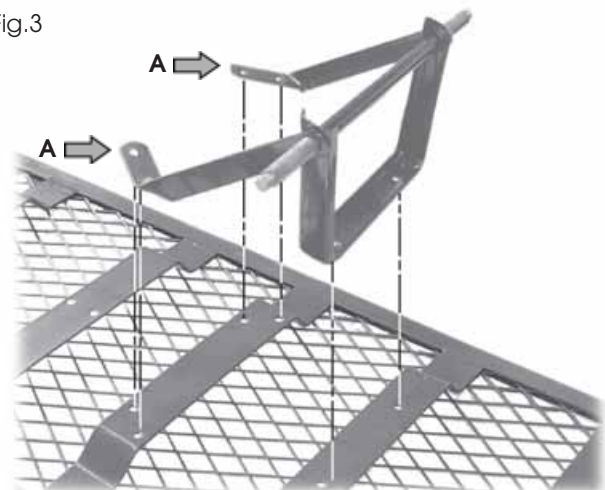

Turn the bed on its back and attach the steering linkage using the bolts, flat washers and locknuts supplied as shown in fig.2. **NOTE:** Flat washers should be used against the nuts.

Slide the braces 'A', over the ends of the rear axle, attach the assembly to the bed using the bolts, flat washers and locknuts supplied as shown in fig.3. **NOTE:** Flat washers should be used against the nuts.

Attach the wheels ensuring a spacer (circled in fig.4) is placed over each stub axle first. Secure the wheels using the supplied flat washers, spring washers and nuts. As shown in fig.5.

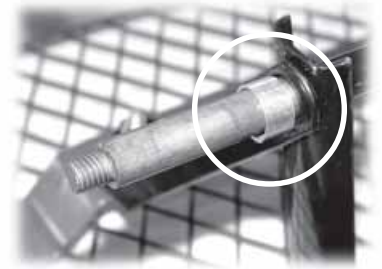

Slide the handle into the trunnion and attach the assembly to the yolk on the steering assembly as shown in fig.6.

Slide the pin through the yolk and trunnion and secure with the supplied washer and 'R' clip.

Attach the fences to the bed by using the supplied 'R' clips as shown in fig.7. If desired place the removable liner in the cart and clip to the fences.
